Subject : Mock Trading for New TradeX Version 3.0.8

The Exchange is pleased to announce the release of new version (3.0.8) of TradeX. For the benefit of members, a mock trading session will be conducted for the same on Sunday, November 01, 2009 from 10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. **The new version will become compulsory for all members using TradeX from Monday, November 02, 2009.** This would be available for all members connected through VSAT, Leased Line and Internet. All users are requested to download the new version which will be available from Friday, October 30, 2009, 9.00 a.m. onwards.

Important: *Members are requested to take backup of the existing version before downloading the new version for mock session.*

Following features have been enabled on new TradeX 3.0.8

1. Facility provided to enter the quantity in terms of Board Lot Quantity or Absolute Quantity for order entry
2. Facility to Cancel All pending orders through Quick Cancel (Shift+F3) and Outstanding orders screen (F3)
3. Facility to view Net Profit or Loss in the Previous Trades (F8) screen
4. Facility to open three Market Depth (F6) windows simultaneously
5. Contract Multiplier is now displayed in Contract Descriptor (Shift F8) screen
6. Background colour of the Buy Screen (F1) changed to blue and the same for the Sell Screen (F2) changed to red for better usability
7. Facility to submit the order using Ctrl+Enter or Only Enter

Members are advised to participate actively in the mock session to familiarise themselves with the features in the new version. Members are **required** to log-in to live environment after end of mock trading to check for connectivity and other log-in issues. Members using CTCL facility are also advised to actively participate in the mock trading session using CTCL software.

Upon successful completion of the mock trading, TradeX v3.0.8 will become active from Monday, November 2nd, 2009. Members, who have not downloaded and installed the new version of the software, will not be able to participate in the live trading sessions using older versions of TradeX, from Monday November 02, 2009.

Note:

1. Existing version of Trader 3.0.7, i.e. NEAT, will continue to be active. Member can participate in live trading sessions using Trader v3.0.7 (NEAT).
2. CTCL users are not affected by this release. However, these users are also required to participate in the mock and check for connectivity and log-in issues after the mock.

(A) Schedule for the Mock Trading session:

Login Allowed	: From 9.30 a.m. onwards
Session for non-global commodities	: 10:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.
Session for global commodities	: 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
Trade modification time for non-global commodities	: 12:30 p.m. – 12:45 p.m.
Trade modification time for global commodities	: 1:00 p.m. – 1:15 p.m.
Confirmation of Migration to Version 3.0.8	: 2:30 p.m.
Re login to LIVE time	: 3:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.

(B) Step-wise Instructions for Members to install TradeX 3.0.8**Step 1: Backup of Client list**

Members are requested to take a backup of the existing client list and save the same in a secure location in their local drives.

Step 2: Uninstalling existing version of TradeX

- Go to Windows Control Panel and select the "Add/Remove Programs" option. (Start → Settings → Control Panel → Add/Remove Programs)
- From the list of existing programs, select "TradeX-NCDEX Trader Workstation".
- Click on the 'Change/Remove' button to uninstall the software.
- After successful completion of the process, the existing TradeX version should have been uninstalled from the system.

Step 3: Download of TradeX v3.0.8

Starting from this version, TradeX v3.0.8 is available for download in two packages. In addition to the current practice of providing the .zip package, TradeX v3.0.8 is also available in a "Magic Installer" .exe package, which makes the installation of TradeX a 'One-Click' process.

Members are advised to download any one of the packages as per their choice.

Note: Java Run-time Environment (JRE V1.4 or above) is required to use the 'Magic-Installer' for installing TradeX.

- To find out if the system has JRE already, go to Start → Run and type 'cmd' to open an MS-DOS window.
- Type 'java -version' in the command prompt.
- If JRE is present in the system, the system shows the following text (given below example assumes JRE ver 1.6 installed) :

java version "1.6.0_13"

Java(TM) SE Runtime Environment (build 1.6.0_13-b03)

Java HotSpot(TM) Client VM (build 11.3-b02, mixed mode, sharing)

- If JRE is not present, the system will not accept the command. In this case, please download the latest JRE from the URL <http://www.java.com>

(a) To download TradeX from Extranet ISP Server:

- Log on to Extranet
- Go to Common\NCDEXDocuments\TradeX\Installer\TradeX_3.0.8 folder
- Download TradeX_3.0.8.exe file for Magic-Installer package OR Download TradeX_3.0.8.zip file for the .zip package

(b) To download TradeX from NCFE:

- Log on to NCFE
- Go to Member Downloads/Download Files/TradeX/Installer/TradeX_3.0.8 folder
- Download TradeX_3.0.8.exe file for Magic-Installer package OR Download TradeX_3.0.8.zip file for the .zip package

Step 4: Installation of TradeX v3.0.8

Members should note that the new version of TradeX should be installed **only after close of market hours on Saturday, October 31, 2009**

(a) Installation of TradeX v3.0.8 using Magic-Installer

- Double-click the TradeX_3.0.8.exe file
- Follow on-screen instructions
- Installation is complete

(b) Installation of TradeX v3.0.8 using .zip package

- Unzip the file TradeX_3.0.8.zip on Local trading terminal It will contain the following files:
 - Install308.bat
 - Tradex_support
 - Tradex3.0.8
- Open the folder and click on 'Install308.bat'
- Follow installation steps
- Installation is complete. TradeX is installed in Local Drive:\Program Files\TradeX TWS.

(c) Enter Local IP and Relay

- Go to Start → Programs → NCDEX.
- Click on TradeX-NCDEX Trader Workstation

- iii. Press <Ctrl+Space bar> to enter Local IP address and Relay number.

(d) Import the Client List saved in Step 1

Step 5: Upload of contracts

1. On Saturday, October 31, 2009 , after 4.30 p.m., please download "02112009.zip" from the Website (Downloads->Extranet Common Files->NCDEX Docs) or from Extranet ISP Server (Common->NCDEXDocuments)
2. Extract the contents of the zip file to the path C:\Program Files\TradeX TWS\Database for TradeX front-end
3. The following 4 files should be present.
 - ncdex_contract.txt
 - ncdex_participant.txt
 - WarehouseLoc.txt
 - delta_contract.txt
4. Start TradeX front-end
5. Enter User id and password
6. Click on Upload button
7. Select Local Mode and click Ok
8. This will update the contract, participant, warehouse location and delta contract details.
